To star in the show, she enlists Prescott Duke, a former Hollywood actor whose career ended in flames after an accident left him scarred and adrift. He eagerly accepts Maggie's invitation and seizes the chance to reclaim what war has stolen from him.

Inspired by Shakespeare's *Twelfth Night* and "The Twelve Days of Christmas," Maggie and Prescott craft a show at a Shakespearean theater that promises to lift spirits. But as rehearsals progress, Maggie discovers a secret that could transform her production into something unforgettable. With opening night approaching and unexpected feelings complicating everything, Maggie must decide how far she'll go to rewrite not just her show but the outcome for everyone involved.

Sundin weaves together a sweeping World War II romance of redemption and second chances, offering both devoted readers and newcomers an inviting entry point into her celebrated storytelling.



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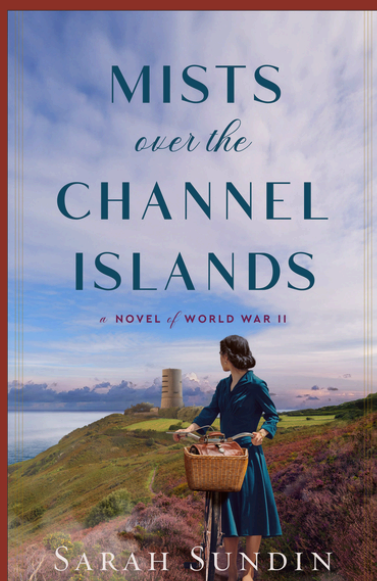
